ORDINANCE NO. 2024 - <u>02</u>

ORDINANCE DECLARING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS USED AT THE SOUTH SEWER PLANT OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE BY THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG.

Whereas; for the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio, it is necessary and appropriate to maintain a modern sewer plant to dispose of effluent, solid and liquid wastes that are generated by users of the south sewer system of the Village of Lewisburg;

And Whereas; the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of a 7 day tank including air system and 5 blowers and motors; DAF unit including all pumps and motors; SS sludge holding tank including all feed pumps and motors; two filter units including all pumps and motors; six chemical tanks including all mixers and blowers; 3RAS/WAS pumps and motors; four submersible effluent pumps; miscellaneous electrical control panels; and miscellaneous pipe and fittings, which are obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village in the Operations of the Waste Water Treatment Plant;

And Whereas; it is not economical to maintain these items and would not be in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Lewisburg to keep the equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council herein finds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of a 7 day tank including air system and 5 blowers and motors; DAF unit including all pumps and motors; SS sludge holding tank including all feed pumps and motors; two filter units including all pumps and motors; six chemical tanks including all mixers and blowers; 3RAS/WAS pumps and motors; four submersible effluent pumps; miscellaneous electrical control panels; and miscellaneous pipe and fittings, which are obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village in the Operations of the Waste Water Treatment Plant and is therefore salvage property with a value of less than \$1,000.

<u>Section 2</u>. Council directs the Municipal Manager to sale to the highest bidder at private sale, auction, or internet auction and/or to dispose of said equipment as salvage.

Section 3. Council directs the Municipal Manager to execute any documents necessary to effectuate transfer of ownership of said equipment to the purchaser, or to effectuate transfer of ownership as salvage.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
