

ORDINANCE NO. 2026 - 03

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THIRTY TRASH DUMPSTERS UNFIT FOR USE BY THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG.

Whereas; for the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio, it is necessary and appropriate to maintain trash dumpsters for use to collect refuse from commercial establishments and rental units;

And Whereas; the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of thirty trash dumpsters which are obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village for refuse collection operations;

And Whereas; it would not be economical to maintain this equipment and would not be in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Lewisburg to keep this equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council herein finds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 thirty trash dumpsters owned by the Village are obsolete, unneeded, and no longer fit to be used by the Village and is therefore salvage property with a value less than \$1,000.

Section 2. Council directs the Village Administrator to dispose of said trash dumpsters.

Section 3. Council directs the Village Administrator to execute any documents necessary to effectuate transfer of ownership of said thirty trash dumpsters to the recipient of same.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
