

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-09

RESOLUTION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.03 IN PREPARATION TO PLACING A TAX LEVY ON THE BALLOT AT THE NOVEMBER 3RD GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO TAX OUTSIDE THE TEN-MILL LIMIT.

That Whereas, the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, Village Council wishes to submit a tax levy to its voters at the November 3, 2026, General Election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Council wishes to place a renewal of an existing outside millage tax levy on the November 3rd, 2026, General Election ballot for its citizens to decide. Council has determined it is necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation. This is a renewal of an existing levy. The millage to be renewed will be 1.00 mills, currently expiring in tax year 2026 (collected in calendar year 2027), with the renewal period to commence in calendar year 2027 (collected in calendar year 2028), and it is to be run for a five-year period of time. The 2026 General Election ballot has been chosen under the authority contained in Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code and other applicable laws. The tax shall be levied upon the entire territory of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, and the ballot measure shall also be submitted to the entire territory of the Village of Lewisburg, Preble County, Ohio, for approval.

Section 2. The purpose of the 1.00 renewal of an existing outside millage levy is listed in Section 5705.19 (H) of the Ohio Revised Code, of which the relevant and applicable part reads as follows:

For Parks and Recreational Purposes.

Section 3. This Resolution requests a prompt response from the Preble County, Ohio Auditor per Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, certifying the total current tax valuation of Lewisburg, Ohio, and the dollar amount of revenue would be generated by said 1.00 mills. Any other appropriate or necessary information from the County Auditor is welcome and acceptable in the response.

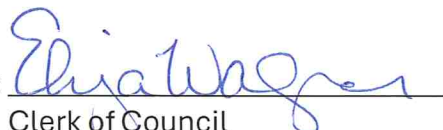
Section 4. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify this Resolution and deliver a certified copy to the County Auditor forthwith.

Section 6. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of said Village Council, and that all deliberations of said Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
