

ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 04

ORDINANCE DECLARING A SEVEN YEAR OLD GERMAN SHEPARD POLICE K-9 NAMED "APOLLO" UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE BY THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG.

Whereas, for the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio, it is necessary and appropriate to maintain a police department complete with a trained Police K-9 to assist in police functions;

And Whereas, the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of a Seven Year Old German Shepard K-9 which due to health is obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village in police functions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council herein finds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 a certain Seven Year Old German Shepard K-9 named "Apollo" owned by the Village is obsolete, unneeded, and no longer fit to be used by the Village and is therefore salvage property with a value of less than \$1,000.

Section 2. Council directs the Municipal Manager to transfer ownership of the Seven Year Old German Shepard K-9 to Andrew Johnson in "as is" condition without warranty, in exchange for assuming the animal's care.

Section 3. Council directs the Municipal Manager to execute any documents necessary to effectuate transfer of ownership of the Seven Year Old German Shepard K-9 named "Apollo".

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
