

ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 05

ORDINANCE DECLARING A 1989 FMC FIRE ENGINE TO BE UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE BY THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG.

Whereas, for the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio, it is necessary and appropriate to maintain a fire department complete with fire apparatus fit for fighting fire;

And Whereas, the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of a 1989 FMC Fire Engine which is obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village to fight fire;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Council herein finds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 a certain 1989 FMC Fire Engine owned by the Village is obsolete, unneeded, and no longer fit to be used by the Village to fight fire and is therefore salvage property with a value of less than \$1,000.

Section 2. Council directs the Municipal Manager to discard the 1989 FMC Fire Engine by transferring same to the Montgomery County Joint Vocational School, or its governing body, for educational use, in an "as is" condition without warranty.

Section 3. Council directs the Municipal Manager to execute any documents necessary to effectuate transfer of ownership of the 1989 FMC Fire Engine to the Montgomery County Joint Vocational School or its governing body at no cost.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
